
## One In Faith ACC Communication

In December 2024, the Diocese of St. Cloud launched an All Things New Campaign to address the Current Reality:

- We must adapt to the changing demographics.
- Sacramental and Catholic household numbers have decreased since 2010.
- As stewards of God's gifts we must use them more effectively.
- Clergy, staff and laity are bearing a heavier administrative burden than in the past.
- The Diocese has 2 assignments that are not able to be filled for July 2025.

### Timeline

- ◆ July 2025 Local Planning Phase: Each ACC will develop a plan, based on common parameters set by the bishop and present it to diocesan leadership for support and approval. Draft due by Dec. 31, 2025.
- ◆ January 2026 Implementation Phase Begins: ACCs begin implementing the changes outlined in the approved plans. Length and timing may vary from ACC to ACC based on local circumstances.

## Design Parameters for the Pastoral Plan created by the Diocese of St. Cloud

# Accessibility to Sunday Mass (includes Saturday evening vigil)

- ♦ 80 % of the faithful must have access to a Sunday Mass within a 20-minute drive.
- No rotation of Mass schedules between churches

## **Budgeted Ministries**

- One administrative office per ACC if under 3000 households.
- Liturgical Ministries.
- Formation Ministries: Children Youth –
   Adult.
- Hispanic ministries with 10% of the total census population.
- Pastoral Care.
- Social Outreach.

### Pastors/Priests

- Limit of three Sunday Masses per weekend/ priest not including weddings/funerals.
- Pastors will spend at least 50% of their time in pastoral ministry.
- Desire to live in community within ACC will be considered.

## **Buildings**

- Overall facility usage must average 50% occupancy or higher for all weekend liturgies in the ACC.
- Buildings must be physically accessible, hospitable and safe.
  - ♦ Restrooms in church building.
  - Church building is either one level or has access to an existing elevator.
- ACC plan must specify how empty buildings will be repurposed or relegated for secular but not unbecoming use ideally within five years.

#### Governance

- Reduce the number of parish corporations.
- Potential Worship Sites Primary Church, Partner Church.

### **Finances**

- Each finance council will approve an attainable and reasonable annual balanced budget.
- Parish investment in Catholic school may not exceed 40% of plate/envelope within five years.
- Routine building operations may not exceed 25% of plate/envelope.
