What: We will be hosting 7 synod listening sessions in our ACC. Pope Francis has invited everyone in the Church to embark on a journey together. Through listening and discernment rooted in the Holy Spirit, the entire People of God are being called to contribute to this process—the synodal process—by which the Church deepens in understanding of her mission and looks toward the future.

Who: EVERYONE is invited to participate in our ACC synod consultation. Pope Francis is inviting all the baptized to participate. This includes parish groups and Catholic organizations, those from other faith traditions, along with persons with special needs and their families, those living in poverty, the incarcerated, migrants and refugees, as well as other marginalized groups. The full voice of all People of God is needed for true discernment as we listen to one another in the Holy Spirit.


